- 1. Welcome:

Principal Mrs. Maya Sawant welcomed all the Advisory members.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting:

Principal Madam read the minutes of the meeting of the previous meeting conducted on Saturday, 31.10.2020, all the points were approved by Advisory Committee members.

Report of the school

Principal Madam further informed the Advisory members about the results at the Maharashtra State Scholarship Exam. She mentioned that this year too, the students have performed extremely well. There are many rankers in the CBSE Merit list. The coaching done at school helps the students to achieve this success. She congratulated the teachers, with special appreciation to Ms Amita Pandit who trains and guides students throughout their scholarship coaching. Students were felicitated at the hands of Hon. Dy. Chief Minister Mr Ajitrao Pawar. He specifically asked the school's name and appreciated the students and the teacher. She further read out the results.

She mentioned about the other activities which were conducted during the past two months-

- The Open day for Periodic test II for all the classes was conducted online.
- The Intra school competition for classes 6th to 10th and its prize distribution was conducted online.
- City Pride School along with Education Department of PCMC conducted an Inter school competition called "Kalarang" for the students of Corporation schools. Our School will be sponsoring prizes worth one lakh for the same. This function will take place in our school in the month of Feb 2021.
- The Counselling and the Softskill department conducted a webinar on Sunday 20th Dec 2020 on work life balance for the parents of Nigdi and Moshi branches.

LKG Admission process for 2021-2022

Principal Madam mentioned that, City Pride School admission process for Nigdi, Moshi and Ravet branches for the academic year 2021-2022 is completed in the month of December 2020.

Selection of teachers for 2021-2022

Principal Madam mentioned that the recruitment process for the selection of teachers for the academic year 2021-2022 for all the three branches of City Pride School is completed.

3. Physical reopening of the school for Std. 5th to 8th

Principal Madam informed parents that keeping in mind the Govt norms and all the precautionary measures ,City Pride School – Nigdi started Std 9th and Std 10th physical classes from 15th Jan 2021 . She further mentioned about guidelines for physical reopening of the classes 5th to 8th . The school needs to obtain consent forms from the parents before reopening of the school physically . She mentioned that the consent forms will be sent online as well as the hard copy will be available in the school office for the parents. Parents need to submit it so that the school can design the further plan of action and send it to the parents. She said now school is taking utmost care and precaution to start the school like daily sanitization of the classes and disinfecting the premises regularly.

School has provided the facilities like sanitizer stands at various places, thermal gun checking at the entrance, oxi-meter are kept ready for checking. Proper flex and sign boards are put in the premises. As per Govt norm - one child on one bench pattern will be followed.

It is mandatory for every child to take care for themselves by following all the required rules i.e. use of mask, sanitizer, no sharing of the same, maintaining social distance etc.

The school would plan to call students of Std 5^{th} to 8^{th} twice a week. The online teaching will be continued along with offline teaching. Details regarding the same will be sent soon. We do understand that children have been at home for a long period and would take time to adjust to physical school.

Mrs Ghate parent of std 7th Faith mentioned that her child was very happy to know that physical school will reopen. She asked about the transport facility. On this, Director Madam Dr Ashwini Kulkarni mentioned that the school would check the consent of the students and the number of students requiring bus facility and then decide whether school can provide bus facility. Depending upon the requirement school will have to rearrange the bus routes.

Mrs Ghate has another query regarding the school uniform?

Ashwini madam explained that incase the school uniform does not fit the shild then they can

Ashwini madam explained that incase the school uniform does not fit the child then they can come to school in proper civil dress.

Mrs Kotansthane raised a query - if after filling the consent for Yes, child is not well then will he /she be marked absent?

Ashwini Madam said that in case any child is not well then he/she can attend the online classes. Mrs Kotanthane had a query - Is antigen test is compulsory for students?

Ashwini Madam explained that Antigen is not compulsory for the students. It depends on parents wish.

Mr Yogendra Khatavkar of Std 5th Love asked whether he could convey to the parents to resume physical school.

Ashwini madam said, let the parents decide for themselves whether they wish to attend physical school or continue with online teaching. The school does not make it compulsory for the same.

Mr Purohit parent of 5th Joy, asked whether the next academic year will start after the final exam or school will have vacation?

Ashwini madam answered that if the situation improves drastically and the vaccination starts then the school will plan everything as usual.

Mr Purav Mutha said all the other public places are open, so why not school start for students in full fledge? He further asked whether exams are going to be conducted online or offline? Ashwini madam said soon the school will decide and inform the parents.

Mrs Pradnya Jadhav parent of 7^{th} Vigour asked whether the consent form needs to be submitted of the answer is "NO".

Ashwini madam answered only if the answer is "YES" parents need to submit the hard copy of the consent duly signed in the school office.

Mr Mangire Satyajeet 7^{th} Vigour suggested why students can not be called physically for full day school.

Ashwini madam answered, as per Govt norms we can run the physical school for 3 - 4 hours. This would enable the students to go home and have lunch. Gradually as the situation improves the Govt may decide to increase the time.

Mrs Raj, parent of 4^{th} Joy asked whether the school will continue to share notes for the students through MS team.

Ashwini madam said it is going to blended learning. School will keep on sending the notes through MS team.

Mrs Mahambare appreciated the teachers and the school management. She suggested that the exam should be offline.
